

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Front View




Top View



Bottom View




Passenger's Side View



Installation Instructions:

Step 1

Remove the Factory Floor Plate by removing the 2 bolts located under the dash, 2 inside the cutouts on top of the plate and bolts on the back side of the plate. Retain the hardware for new consoles.

Step 2


Remove the factory lower dash section by loosening the 2 screws location on either side using a 7mm socket.





CAUTION: The lower dash section has wiring harnesses that are attached.

Disconnect the three highlighted wiring harnesses located at the back of the lower dash section.





Step 4

Remove the factory accessories from the lower dash section. Retain the hardware.



CAUTION: DO NOT hammer or force the plastic covers. They have a pin on each side, that must be pressed using a small flat-head screwdriver when installing.

Attach the lower dash section back in. Run the three harnesses through the hole that used to house the parking brake. Bolt the section back in place using the 2 bolts removed in step 1.



Step 6

Re-install both USB port and cigarette lighter on the top of new console, as shown below in the left image.


Remove the faceplate located on the driver' side of the new console and attach the factory emergency brake switch to the back using the factory screws removed in the previous step. Re-install the faceplate into side of console.





Step 7

Detach the Console Mid Mounting Base from the console by un-fastening the nuts located on inside, retain the hardware.



Remove the indicated 6 factory nuts, using a 10 mm socket. Retain the hardware for future steps.



Step 9Disconnect the wiring harnesses located as shown below.





Mount the Console Mid Mounting Base using the nuts removed in the previous step. Ensure to apply pressure on the Console Mid Mounting Base towards the front of the vehicle while tightening down.






Step 11

Place the new console on top of the Console Mid Mounting Base. Push the console forward tight to the dash and secure with the hardware removed in step 7. Reconnected wiring harnesses to the correct factory accessories.





Attach the console rear cover plate to the back the console as shown using 5/16"-18 X 3/4" Carriage Bolt (x4), 5/16" Lock Washer (x4) and 5/16" Hex Nut (x4) in the four slots at the beginning and end of the rows. Ensure to push firmly on the rear cover plate.
