



Rear View



Top View



Bottom View



Side View



Installation Instructions:


Step 1:

Remove the rear factory flooring both top and bottom, as well as the rear row of seating. This is where the sub frame will be sitting.




Step 2:


Assemble the following parts as shown below. Use the fourteen 1/4" Hex bolts, flat and lock washers. This is easiest done by putting the mounting legs in first and then laying the supports overtop.



Step 3:


Install the shelf welds (A) and place the stiffener covers (F), secure in place using 1/4" flathead screw (3/4") x 28.





Step 4:

Attach the entire sub frame to the vehicle using the factory bolts. Both front and back need to be tight to keep the sub frame secure during transit.



Repeat for the other side, not shown.

Step 5:

Attach the front support using 10-32 X 1/2" Flathead machine screws. The piece is meant to be a tight fit so the plastic may have to be moved a little to get it into place. Once tightened down the entire sub frame should be mounted correctly.



Step 6:

Slide the lower factory floor back in, the back should line up with the lip on the sub frame. Once complete, the rear factory floor can be reinstalled on top and installation is complete.



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
