

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
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#### UNPACKING

HARDWARE PARTS LIST

Before beginning any installation, unpack the equipment received. After unpacking, examine **ALL** components received for any damage that may have occurred while in transit. If any damage has occurred, file a claim **IMMEDIATELY** with the courier stating the extent of damage. Check **ALL** envelopes, packing slips, shipping labels and tags before removing or destroying them. To ensure your satisfaction, open all cartons and report any shortages <u>within 48 hours of receipt</u>.

#### **VEHICLE PREPARATION**


Remove the 2nd row seats and both rear Door Panels and set aside. Ensure Window switches are reconnected and tucked away. Cover switches with a plastic bag to create a hydro shield. Remove 2nd row seat belt bolts. Some Plastic floor panels may require removal as well. Seat bolts will be used to fasten the sub-frame to the floor. Remove Hook/Hangers on the roof above the 2nd row seats.

Contact D&R if you are unsure how to remove the Seats or Door Panels.

#### **INSTALLATION OF K9 UNIT**

#### Step 1 Sub-frame into Vehicle

Place sub-frame over the seat mount holes. Separate the Seat-Belt bolts from their brackets. Tuck the brackets under the sub-frame replace the Seat-Belt bolts as shown on the right. Secure the Sub-frame using the 8x factory Seat bolts.





#### Step 2 Floor Panel to Sub-frame

Place Floor panel on sub-frame. Do not secure.



#### Step 3

#### Back Panel to Floor Panel & Sub-frame

Place Back panel on sub-frame and secure with Sub-frame using (4x) 1/4-20 - 3/4" Hex Bolt, 1/4" Lock Washer and 1/4" Flat Washer. Secure Back panel to Floor Panel using (13x) 1/4-20 - 3/4" Round Head Bolt, 1/4" Lock Washer and 1/4" Flat Washer





### Step 4 Roof Brackets and Panel


Place DS & PS Roof Mtg Brkts and secure to Hook/Hanger locations using(2x) #10 Machine screws, #10 Lock Washers and #10 Fender Washers. Do not tighten until end of step 5. Place Roof Panel on back panel and secure to Back Panel and Roof Brkts using (7x) 1/4-20-3/4" Round Head Bolt, 1/4" Lock Washer and 1/4" Flat Washer






#### Step 5 Front Panel to Roof Panel, Floor Panel & Sub-frame


Place Front Panel on Sub-frame and secure using (5x) 1/4-20-5/8" Hex Head Bolt, 1/4" Washers & 1/4" Lock Washers. Secure Front Panel to Roof Panel and Floor Panel using (16x) 1/4-20-5/8" Round Head Bolt, 1/4" Lock Washer and 1/4" Flat Washer.





#### Step 6 Door Exit Upper Covers

Place the DS and PS Door Exit upper covers and secure using (7x each) 1/4-20-3/4" Hex Bolt, 1/4" Lock Washer and 1/4" Flat Washer



#### Step 7 Door Slides on Front Panel

Separate the Slide pieces by pressing the black disconnect lever on the slide. Place the slides on the Front Panel and secure using (3x each) #10 Round head screw, #10 washer and #10 Nylock Nuts. Fasten but do not tighten until end of Step 8. Note that the door slides towards the Drivers Side.



## Step 8

## Door Slides on the Sliding Door


Place the disconnected part of the slides onto the sliding door and secure using rivets. If rivets are not available use (3x each) #10 Round head screw, #10 washers and #10 nylock nuts. Place and connect the door onto the main slides. Ensure smooth movement and tighten the main slides left loose in Step 7.



Step 9 Rubber Matting Place Rubber Matting on the base tray. CAUTION MATTING MAY BE HEAVY.


### Step 10 Door Skins

Place the Door Skins on the Door and Secure using rivets. If rivets are not available use (4x each) self tapping screws provided. Note that if any aftermarket products, such as door release solenoids, must be mounted such that they do not protrude past the speaker frame. Sample image shown below.




## Step 11 DS & PS Window Guards


Place Hinges on the Window Guards Secure using Rivets. If rivets are not available use (6x each) #10 Round Head Screw, #10 Lock Washers and #10 Nylock Nuts. Then place the window guards on the door and secure using Rivets. If rivets are not available, use (6x each) Self Tapping Screws.



#### Step 13 DS & PS Window Guard Brackets


Place the DS & PS Window Guard Brackets on the Window Guards and secure using (2x each) 1/4-20 x 3/4 Round Head Bolt, 1/4" Washer, 1/4" Lock Washer. Secure the Brackets to the Door using rivets or (4x each) self tapping screws provided.





#### Step 14 Exit Door Covers to Door Skins

Place the exit door covers onto the door skins and secure using 3x - 1/4-20 X 3/4 Hex Bolts, 3x 1/4-20 Nylock Nuts 3x 1/4 Lock washers and 6x 1/4" Flat Washers. Fasten but do not tighten until end of Step 15. Repeat for opposite door.



### Step 15 Exit Door Cover Supports

Place the exit door cover support and secure to door skin using (4x each)  $1/4-20 \times 3/4$  Hex Bolts, 1/4" Lock Washers and 1/4" Flat Washers. Secure the Exit door cover supports to the Exit door covers using (4x each)  $1/4-20 \times 3/4$  Hex Bolts, 1/4-20 Nylock Nuts and 1/4" Flat Washers. Tighten the Hardware left loose in Step 15.
