

INSTALLATION MANUAL




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UNPACKING

Before beginning any installation, unpack the equipment received. After unpacking, examine **ALL** components received for any damage that may have occurred while in transit. If any damage has occurred, file a claim **IMMEDIATELY** with the courier stating the extent of damage. Check **ALL** envelopes, packing slips, shipping labels and tags before removing or destroying them. To ensure your satisfaction, open all cartons and report any shortages **within 48 hours of receipt**.

VEHICLE PREPARATION


Remove the 2 rear seats and set aside. Some Plastic floor panels may require removal as well. The removed seat bolts will be used to fasten the sub-frame to the floor. Remove Driver and Passenger Side Rear door panels and set aside.

Contact D&R if you are unsure how to remove the Seats or Door Panels.

INSTALLATION OF K9 UNIT Step 1


Sub-frames into Vehicle

Place the cabinet subframe and the K9 sub-frame over the seat mount holes and studs. Center the sub-frame & secure using all factory seat bolts and nuts.




Step 2 Bottom Cabinet and Support Brackets to Subframe

Place and secure bottom cabinet assembly on the subframe in the front and the support brackets on the subframe in the back.




Step 3 K9 Main Base Panel

Place the base panel on the bottom cabinet assembly and the support brackets and secure using $1/4-20 \times 3/4$ " Flat head screws.




Step 4 Rear and Front Panel Assembly to Base Panel

Install and secure the rear and front panel assembly to the base panel using 1/4-20 x 3/4" Hex bolt and washers. Front Panel assembly also requires #10 hardware and include the sliding doors and handle bar. Place rubber mat on the base panel.




Step 4 Centre Dividers

Place the two divider panels between the rear panel and front panel. Secure together and to the rear and front panel using 1/4-20 x 3/4" Hex bolts and washers.




Step 5 Side Panels to Back Panel

Place Install side panels and secure to base panel and rear panel using 1/4-20 and #10 hardware.




Step 6 Roof Panel

Place the roof panel over the components and secure to the front, rear, side and divider panels using 1/4-20 hardware.




Step 7 Door Exit Panels

Install the DS and PS door exit panels and secure to the side and the front panels using 1/4-20 hardware.




Step 8
OPTIONAL: Battery Box and Electronics Box
Install the battery and electronics box to the base of the K9 unit.




Step 9 Door Panel and Window Guard

Install the door panel and window guard on the PS door as shown below using $10x + 10 \times 3/4$ " self tapping screws. Secure the window guard to the top brackets using $2x + 1/4 - 20 \times 5/8$ " Screws and washers and to the door panel using 3x + 1/4 - 20 Nylock nuts and washers. Repeat for DS



Step 10 Bowl Holding Brkt

Install the bowl holding brkt on the door panel and secure using $4x \frac{1}{4-20} x \frac{3}{4}$ " Hex bolts and washers. Then, mount the water bowl in place.
