UNPACKING


Install the Vehicle Specific Sub frame in the vehicle. Refer to the Sub frame Installation instructions for installing the Sub frame.

INSTALLATION OF STORAGE UNIT

Step 1

Remove Cabinet Top

Remove all the Bolts located on the top of the cabinet and carefully lift the cabinet top and place aside.





Step 8 (OPTIONAL) **Insert Partition** Insert Cabinet and Vehicle Specific Cargo partition.




Step 9 Secure Partition


Secure Partition and Cabinet Top using remaining hardware obtained in step one. Some partitions may require additional straps and/or hardware.

Check Mounting location points Carefully open the drawer. Measure and evaluate the mounting locations of the cabinet. Number of mounting holes may vary based on the size of the unit.






Step 3 Place Retainer Nuts on Sub frame locations found in Step 2..


Step 4
