



Installation Instructions

INTERIOR SIDE BACK WINDOW GUARDS


Step 1

- A. Test fit window guard without mounting brackets to ensure proper fitting.
 B. Ensure the larger/rounder corner is pointing to the rear of the vehicle



Step 2


A. Mount 3 bottom mount brackets indicated by straight corners to the side window guard using the 10-32 x 5/8" Bolt, #10 Nyloc Nut and #10 Washer. DO NOT TIGHTEN.




B. Angle's may need to be slightly altered dependent on fit.

Step 3

A. Mount 4 side mount brackets indicated by rectangular slots to the side window guard using the 10-32 x 5/8" Bolt, #10 Nyloc Nut and #10 Washer. DO NOT TIGHTEN.







B. Angle's may need to be slightly altered dependent on fit.

Step 4

A. Mount 3 top mount brackets indicated by the round corners to the side window guard using the 10-32 x 5/8" Bolt, #10 Nyloc Nut and #10 Washer. DO NOT TIGHTEN.






B. Angle's may need to be slightly altered dependent on fit.

NOTE: EXTRA SLOTS GIVEN FOR HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT WHEN MOUNTING TO VEHCILE. COMPLETE ALL STEPS FOR BOTH RIGHT AND LEFT SIDE WINDOW GUARDS.

Step 5

Remove plastic covers around the cargo window as shown in the below figure, to allow access to the metal frame for direct mounting of the window guards.




Step 6

Place the windows guards against the window (not touching) and align the brackets with the metal frame. Ensure the brackets have been placed flush against the metal frame, tighten the brackets to the window guard to ensure proper fitting. At this point, some slight alteration bending may be required on the brackets to acquire a more accurate fit. Mark off mounting locations and pre drill small guide holes for the self tap screws.

Step 7

Re-align the cargo window guard with the pre-drilled holes and use 10-32 x 3/4" Self Tap Screws to mount the guards to the vehicle. Once window guards are in place, put all plastic panels back and cut slots into panels to allow relief for the mounting brackets.




Window guards installed with plastic panels back in original locations

Step 8


- A. Install 5 mount brackets indicated by the multiple bends to the hatch window guard using the 10-32 x 5/8" Bolt, #10 Nyloc Nut and #10 Washer. DO NOT TIGHTEN
 - guard using the 10-32 x 5/8"
 Bolt, #10 Nyloc Nut and #10
 Washer. DO NOT TIGHTEN.

Step 9

Remove rear cargo hatch plastic panel to expose metal trim for mounting.

Slot



Step 10

Place the hatch window guard against the window (not touching) and align the brackets with the metal frame. Ensure the brackets have been placed flush against the metal frame, tighten the brackets to the window guard to ensure proper fitting. At this point, some slight alteration bending may be required on the brackets to acquire a more accurate fit. Mark off mounting locations and pre drill small guide holes for the self tap screws.

Step 11

Re-align the hatch window guard with the pre-drilled holes and use 10-32 x 3/4" Self Tap Screws to mount the guard to the vehicle. Once hatch window guard is in place, put the plastic panel back and cut slots into the panel to allow relief for the mounting brackets. Installation concluded.



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
